Phase 1: Stabilization

approx. 60 days

- Obtain Drug & Alcohol Evaluation/Assessment
- Obtain additional Evaluations as needed (MH, MAT, DV, etc.)
- Develop & Comply with treatment / case plan
- Attend Program orientation
- Attend 1-3 support meetings per week (i.e. Alcoholics Anonymous, NA, Smart Recovery, Church, REACH TOO, Pro-Social Activities)
- Submit Weekly Web-Report
- Complete Life Skills requirement
- Encourage mentor contact
- Random drug/alcohol tests
- Curfew 9 p.m. (unless given permission to be different)
- Weekly visits w/ probation and/or case manager if applicable
- Court Weekly

SHOW UP. BE HONEST.

ASK FOR HELP!

Phase 2: Planning

approx. 90 days

- Comply w/ Treatment Plan
- Attend 2-3 support meetings per week
- Do Web-Report week of court
- Complete Life Skills requirement
- Encourage mentor contact
- Weekly check-in's w/ Probation and/or case manager
- Random drug/alcohol tests
- Curfew 10 p.m.
- Court every other week
- Make \$10 payments before court

INCREASE SUPPORT SYSTEM

Rewards Used:

- Decreased Requirements
- Praise & Recognition
- Weekly & Monthly Gift Cards
- Sobriety Coins
- Approval of trip permits
- Sober Activities/ Support Candy
- Referrals to other resources

Phase 3: Action

approx. 90 days

- Comply with Treatment Plan
- Attend 3 support meetings per week
- Do Web-Report week of court
- Complete Life Skills requirement
- Bi-weekly check-in's w/ Probation and/or case manager
- Random drug/alcohol tests
- Encourage Mentor contact
- Curfew 11:00 pm
- Make \$25 payments before court
- Court Monthly on the 3rd week of the month

SET GOALS. REDUCE BARRIERS!

Sanctions Used:

- Writing Assignments
- Increased Court/Meetings
- Demotion in Phase
- Decreased Curfew & Travel requests
- Community Service/Work Crew
- Residence Change
- House Arrest / Jail

Phase 4: Maintenance

approx. 120 days

- Complete Treatment plan goals
- Attend 3+ support meetings per week
- Court 1x month on 4th week of month
- Monthly check-ins with probation and/or case manager
- Random drug/alcohol tests
- Employment/Education/ Volunteer required
- Do Web-Report week of court
- Complete 4 Advisory/Alumni Mtgs OR 6 week support circles
- Write letter to arresting officer
- Curfew midnight.
- Make \$50 payments before court

GIVE BACK. GET INVOLVED!

Reasons For Termination:

- Warrant Status
- New Charges/Illegal Behavior
- Unsuccessful discharge from treatment program
- Chronic Non-Compliance / Continued Dishonesty

Sanctions & Termination Decisions are solely at Judges Discretion

Phase Advancement Criteria

To Apply for Phase 2:

- Minimum of 60 days since opting in
- Minimum of 2 weeks full compliance (no sanctions)
- Minimum of 30 days court clean & sober time
- Engaged in Treatment
- Life Skills completed (if a longer-term course, attended at least 4 sessions)
- Attended REACH Too Open House and at least 1 Reach Too event
- Submitted Phase Up application for team's approval at least one week in advance to allow team to review
- Minimum Payment of \$50 towards program fee
- Resolved any outstanding warrants in any other jurisdiction (other than financial obligations)

To Apply for Phase 3

- Minimum of 90 days in Phase 2
- Minimum of 2 weeks full compliance (no sanctions)
- Minimum of 45 days court clean & sober time
- Minimum of \$100 payments towards program fee in this phase (total paid \$150)
- Progress/compliance with treatment plan
- Attended at least 4 sessions of Life Skills Classes
- Attended at least 1 REACH Too Event/activity
- Submitted Phase Up application for team's approval at least one week in advance to allow team to review

To Apply for Phase 4

- Minimum of 90 days in Phase 3
- Minimum of 30 days full compliance (no sanctions)
- Minimum of 60 days court clean & sober time
- Minimum of \$200 payments towards program fee in this phase (total of \$350)
- Progress/compliance with treatment plan
- Working on future goals of vocational training, employment, GED / school and/or giving back as a volunteer or mentor
- Attended at least 4 sessions of Life Skills Classes
- Attended at least 1 REACH Too event/activity
- Submitted Phase Up application for team's approval at least one week in advance to allow team to

To Apply for Graduation

- Minimum of 120 days in Phase 4
- Minimum of 1 year in program
- Minimum of 30 days full compliance (no sanctions)
- Minimum of 90 days court clean & sober time
- Full \$600 program fee paid in full
- Successfully completed all treatment plan goals/conditions
- Write letter to Arresting Officer
- Complete 4 Advisory/Alumni Mtgs OR 6 week support circles
- Currently working, in school or volunteering an average of 15 hrs each week
- Submitted Graduation application for team's approval one month in advance to allow team to review



Each Phase has an Enhancement Track (1.5, 2.5, 3.5, 4.5) if working closely with Mentor and built-in rewards like a later curfew, called earlier on docket & mugs!
